CFO COLLECTIONS - will take place in the Lobby from 12/1 - 12/18

CFO Collections - Collections will take place in the lobby area or in classrooms from December 1 - December 18. The different collections include: The Mitten Tree, Toy Collection, The St. Francis of Assisi Animal Care Project, Cookies for Coats and Brownies for Blankets, Santa's Sock Collection, Soup for the Soul, Promise for Haiti Collection, Babies in Need, Book Collection, Sports Equipment, and School Supplies/Backpacks.

The Mitten Tree- Padua's official Christmas tree, sponsored by the Robotics Club. Place new mittens, hats, or scarves on the tree. Donations will be given to the West Side Catholic Center.

Toy Collection- Sponsored by NHS. *New toys* are requested for this venerable charitable effort. All donations will be given to the Bishop Cosgrove Center.

The St. Francis of Assisi Animal Care Project- Sponsored by the Junior Class and Environmental Club. The donation wish list includes the following items: Toilet Paper, White Copy Paper, HE Laundry Detergent, No Scent Fabric Softener, Gift Cards for Pet Stores, Clay litter (not scoopable), Adult Cat Pate Wet Food – Friskies, Fancy Feast (no shreds), Adult Cat Dry Hill's Science Diet, Cases of canned Pro Plan Kitten, All Sizes DOG Martingale collars, Dry and canned Royal Canin Baby Cat, Hill's Science Diet for dogs, dry and wet, Hill's Science Diet for kittens, dry and wet, Two-Pocket/Clasp Folders – solid colors, 33 and 95 gallon garbage bags, Birdseed for our feeders, Dish Detergent, 6 ft Nylon Dog Leashes All donations will be given to the Parma Animal Shelter.

Cookies for Coat and Brownies for Blankets- The Student Leadership Core and Freshman Class will be collecting new and gently used clean coats to help those in Northeast Ohio. Every Thursday during lunch periods, they will exchange cookies and brownies for coat donations. The coat bin may be moved down to the cafeteria during this time.

Santa's Sock Collection- MedTrack and Sophomore Class will be collecting **men's socks** - preferably warm socks - for Lutheran Men's Shelter. These donations will be given to residents of the shelter who are unhoused.

Soup for the Soul- Sponsored by the English Department. All English classes will be collecting any kind of canned soup to be donated to Parma, Food Bank and All Faiths Pantry. The goal is for each student to bring in four (4) cans of soup each.

Promise for Haiti Collection- Sponsored by MedTrack. MedTrack students will be collecting toothbrushes, toothpaste, floss, and soap (non-liquid) for all ages. Donations will be given to the Promise for Haiti Dental Clinic.

Babies in Need - Sponsored by the Senior Class. Seniors will be collecting diapers, baby wipes, baby blankets, baby lotion, and formula. Donations will be given to Birthcare of Medina County.

Book Collection- Sponsored by the Environmental Club. The Environmental Club will be collecting new and gently-used books for children and adolescents. They are also in need of books for teens as well. The age range is 0-18. Age appropriate themes, along with the need for books that show diversity, are encouraged. Donations will be given to the Kid's Book Bank which provides free books to children in the Greater Cleveland area.

Play it Forward - Sponsored by Key Club and SAAC. Collect new or gently used sports equipment, balls, cleats, and/or any other items related to a sport. If the student wouldn't use the item again, then it is too worn to be donated. One donation equals one hour of service with a cap at 3 hours, but students are welcome to donate more than three items. If an item comes as a pair - for example catcher's shin guards - that counts as one item and gets one hour of service.

Beyond Belief - Sponsored by the Young Educators' Society. Beyond Belief is a foundation rooted in faith and community service, dedicated to easing the financial burden that families often face when preparing for a new school year. Their mission is to support families in need by providing essential school supplies and backpacks, while also creating a joyful and uplifting community event through their annual Back-to-School Giveaway.

Candy Cane Cafe (12/1 - 12/19): For Faculty and Staff only located in the Faculty Lounge A festive location for teachers to go make coffee, hot chocolate, hear holiday music, etc.

Nachos for Niños (12/1 - 12/5) – Spanish Club invites you to enjoy nachos and cheese for the low price of \$2, available during all lunch periods! Feliz Navidad!

Christmas Gift Shop (12/1 - 12/5): Shop for Christmas gifts! Brand new Christmas merchandise, decor, ornaments, etc. are available for purchase in the Library for \$1-\$5 each (donated by Petitti Garden Centers). Cash or Venmo accepted.
